



### Size:

The finished size of Ballerina Birdy will be approximately 5.1 inch (13 cm), in seating position, by using the materials as named below.

### Materials:

Catania white, 1 ball of yarn (50 gram, 125 m).

Catania light pink.

Catania dark pink.

Catania orange, for the beak, legs and feet.

Fiberfill stuffing.

Crochet hook size C (2,5 mm).

Tapestry needle.

Two safety eyes 8 mm.

Optional: pipe cleaner for the legs.

### About this pattern:

This amigurumi is worked in continuous rounds, do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed. If you wish to make a taller or smaller version of this amigurumi you can just use thicker or thinner yarn and crochet hook.

Instead of crocheting 2 chain and then working the next stitches of the 1<sup>st</sup> round in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, you can also start with a magic ring. Use a stitch marker to mark the start of each round and move it up as you go along. After you have finished a part, leave a long tail for assembling pieces later. Enjoy crocheting!

## Stitches used and abbreviations (US terms):

Ch = chain

Slst = slip stitch

Sc = single crochet

Hdc = half double crochet

Dc = double crochet

Dec = decrease (work 2 stitches together)

Inc = increase (2 stitches in same stitch)

## Body

Ch 2 in white.

**1)** 6 sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook (6) (or 6 sc in magic ring)

**2)** (inc) 6x (12), change light pink

**3)** (sc, inc) 6x (18), change white

**4)** (2 sc, inc) 6x (24), change light pink

**5)** (3 sc, inc) 6x (30), change white

**6)** (4 sc, inc) 6x (36), change light pink

**7)** (5 sc, inc) 6x (42), change white

**8)** (6 sc, inc) 6x (48), change light pink

**9)** (7 sc, inc) 6x (54), change white

**10)** (8 sc, inc) 6x (60), change light pink

**11)** (9 sc, inc) 6x (66), change white

**12)** (10 sc, inc) 6x (72), change light pink

**13)** (11 sc, inc) 6x (78), change white

**14)** (12 sc, inc) 6x (84), change light pink

**15)** sc around, change white

**16)** sc around, change light pink

**17)** sc around, change white

**18)** sc around, change light pink

**19)** sc around, change white

**20)** (12 sc, dec) 6x, in back loops only (so the tutu can be crocheted in the front loops later) (78)

**21)** (11 sc, dec) 6x (72)

**22)** (10 sc, dec) 6x (66)

**23)** (9 sc, dec) 6x (60)

**24)** (8 sc, dec) 6x (54)

**25)** (7 sc, dec) 6x (48)

**26)** (6 sc, dec) 6x (42)

**27-43)** sc around

Place the safety eyes between rounds 39 and 40, with a space of 8 sc between the eyes, see photo 1. Start stuffing and continue stuffing as you go along.

**44)** (5 sc, dec) 6x (36)

**45)** (2 sc, dec) 9x (27)

**46)** (sc, dec) 9x (18)

**47)** (dec) 9x (9)

**48)** (dec) 4x, sc (5)



Photo 1

Fasten off, insert the needle under the front loop of each stitch, pull through, tighten.  
Weave in the yarn end.

## Beak

Ch 2 in orange.

- 1) 4 sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook (4) (or 4 sc in a magic ring)
  - 2) (inc) 4x (8)
  - 3) (sc, inc) 4x (12)
  - 4) (2 sc, inc) 4x (16)
  - 5) (3 sc, inc) 4x (20)
  - 6) (hdc) 2x, 2 sc, inc, 2 sc, (hdc) 2x, hdc inc, (hdc) 2x, 2 sc, inc, 2 sc, (hdc) 2x, (hdc, sc) in next stitch (24)
- Slst, fasten off. Flatten the beak and sew it onto the body, see photos 2-4.

## Wings

Make 2. Ch 4 in white.

- 1) 6 sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook (6) (or 6 sc in magic ring)
- 2) (inc, inc, sc) 2x (10)
- 3) sc around
- 4) (inc, sc, inc, sc, inc) 2x (16)
- 5) sc around
- 6) (inc, 2 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, sc) 2x (22)
- 7) sc around
- 8) (inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 2 sc) 2x (28)
- 9) sc around
- 10) (2 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec) 2x (22)
- 11) (sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, sc, dec) 2x (16)
- 12) (sc, dec) 5x, sc (11)

Fasten off. Flatten the wing and sew the open part together with a few stitches, see photo 5.  
Attach the wings onto the body between rounds 27 and 28, see photos 6-7.

## Legs

Make 2.

- 1) Ch 14 in orange
- 2) sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 12 sc (13)
- 3-5) ch 1, turn, sc across (13)

Fasten off, see photo 8. Fold lengthwise and sew together. Optional: you can sew a pipe cleaner onto the inside of the leg so it can bend.



## Feet

Make 2. Ch 2 in orange

- 1) 5 sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook (5), (or 5 sc in a magic ring)
- 2) (inc) 5x (10)
- 3) sc around
- 4) (sc, inc) 5x (15)
- 5) sc around
- 6) (2 sc, inc) 5x (20)
- 7) sc around
- 8) (3 sc, inc) 5x (25)
- 9) sc around

Flatten, working through both layers (see photos

9-12):

- 10) dc, 3 dc in next stitch, slst, (slst, dc, 3 dc in next stitch, slst) 2x (17)

Fasten off, weave in the yarn end and sew the legs perpendicular on the feet. See photos 13-14. Attach the legs at the bottom of the body between round 5 and 6, see photos 15-16

### Tutu

Crochet the tutu in the front loops of round 20. Keep the body upside down while you crochet the tutu.

- 1) Pull up a loop in dark pink (see photo 17), (inc) 84x (168)
- 2) (sc, inc) 84x (252), change light pink
- 3) sc around

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end.

### Flowers

Make 7.

I used white, light pink and dark pink for the inside of the flowers, and light pink and dark pink for the outside, see photos 18-20. Ch 2 in a color of your choice.

- 1) 10 sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook (10) (or 10 sc in magic ring). Change color.
- 2) (3 dc in next stitch, slst) 5x.

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. Attach the flowers around the head. Use only the inside of the flowers to attach the flowers, so the flowers are not too tight. And ready is your Ballerina Birdy!
